

Florida South (Area 10) ASSEMBLY

Removal/Resignation of Area Coordinator Policy

If any Area Coordinator fails to perform the duties of that position, which includes providing written reports, and/or does not attend any two (2) meetings during a twelve (12) month period (from the first missed meeting), including Florida South (AREA 10) ASSEMBLY or Area World Service Committee (AWSC) Meetings, the Area Chairperson may ask for their resignation.

- If the Area Coordinator does not submit their resignation, and there is just cause, they may be removed by a motion that is made and passed at the AWSC or Florida South (Area 10) ASSEMBLY Meeting and the Area Coordinator will be removed effective immediately.
1. Should a Coordinator position become vacant due to removal or resignation, the Area Chairperson may appoint an Interim Coordinator, who meets eligibility requirements for that position, until the next Florida South (Area 10) ASSEMBLY Meeting when the vacant Coordinator position will be filled by the method outlined in the Florida South Area 10 Election Procedures.
 2. Should the Coordinator position remain vacant after the next Florida South (Area 10) ASSEMBLY Meeting due to no member being willing to serve, the Interim Coordinator may remain in the position until such time as the position is filled in accordance with #1 above.
